Dunedin Public Art Gallery is now accepting proposals from film and video artists to be part of our 2018 Rear Window Moving Image Programme.

Successful applicants will be awarded a showing fee of \$500.

### CRITERIA

Works will be exhibited on a 75" monitor affixed to the wall and will play 24/7 for the duration of the exhibition. The screen is a Samsung JU6400 Smart 4K UHD TV, measuring 1688.9mm wide by 972.2mm high. Project elements will be limited to onscreen. Artists are asked to consider the prominent public position of the Rear Window and content should therefore be appropriate for a diverse audience. Sound elements are permissible, however applicants should be aware that audio is delivered via a timed speaker system and will play only between 7am and 11pm.

Works can be new or existing. For existing works, please include details of any previous exhibitions or screenings. If there is a specific time of year you feel the work needs to be shown (e.g. because of other exhibition commitments) then please indicate those dates.

Proposals should include a description of the project (1 page maximum) detailing the ideas behind the work, an outline of any physical aspects (such as sound), and the title.

Please also include personal details (name, postal address, email address, phone number), a concise artist's resume (2 page maximum) and up to 3 images and/or links to online video to illustrate the artist's practice.

**Only Word, PDF, jpg or avi files will be accepted.**

### SUBMISSION DETAILS

**Applications close 27 October 2017.**

All applicants will receive an initial confirmation email and will be notified as to the outcome of their proposal by 10 November 2017.
