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### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION:**

We will not accept food, children's toys or cash/voucher donations.

There are a fixed number of prints able to be exchanged on each exchange day. The exchanges will operate on a first come, first served basis.

The exchange process will be managed by Dunedin Public Art Gallery staff, so please do not leave items or remove artworks yourself.

The exchanger (member of the public) can select the print they would like from those available.

The exchanger can leave a message with their items, that will replace their selected print on the wall (paper and pens will be provided).

People are welcome to donate items and not take a print, but these items will be stored outside of the installation.

At the conclusion of the exhibition all of the items will be donated to the Red Cross, to be distributed at their discretion.

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
