- Depending on the number of works to be filmed, advance notice of between 10-20 working days is required before filming can take place.
- Copyright permissions may be required and the Gallery may need to organise technical or security resources to expedite the filming, particularly if works are in storage and need to be unpacked and installed, or if the filming takes place in storage areas.

This form does <u>not</u> constitute permission to reproduce or publish artworks displayed in the galleries. A separate application form for reproduction of artworks from the Gallery's collections must be completed and is available from the Gallery's website.
